ATTENTION Category A Men

The Omnium for 2016 is presented as a Two-Man Team style format. Riders will cumulatively earn points towards their team ranking through the evening. Example: A team winning 1st and 4th in an event would earn 16 omnium points. The Top 8 teams after 6 events will then go on to compete in the Madison to earn final overall points. Solo riders may compete and may earn points towards and place in the Omnium, but will be unable to compete in the Madison event at the end of the evening. Teams must compete in the same jersey and each team must have a unique jersey to wear. No teams with similar jerseys. If your team does not have identical jerseys, jerseys will be provided for you. Solo riders competing for similar sponsor to a team will have no jersey restrictions.

Omnium Tie breaker: Number of wins, second places, third places, if still tied Madison placing will break the tie.

ATTENTION Visiting Riders and Women's OPEN RIDERS:

The EPVA uses unique categories and this will not be a USAC race. To race at the A, B, C or Women's level you must have raced at the Dick Lane Velodrome at least 4 times within the last year, or submit a race resume and references. If you are unsure, please contact Rob Evans, rob@dicklanevelodrome.com well in advance. Any riders with questionable equipment or riding ability will be asked not to race at the discretion of the head official or facility manager. Please do not make the Pro Race weekend your first racing weekend at the Dick Lane Velodrome.

Official Communique # 1

Win and In Rules

- Sprints every 5 laps. First place rider qualifies for final on first 4 x sprints.
- Rider winning multiple sprints reduces the size of final field
- Remaining places will be picked on lap 20.
- After the 4th sprint, there will be 1 neutral lap to clear track leaving up to 4 (or fewer) riders on track.
- After neutral, bell will ring for final sprint.
- Qualifying sprint win guarantees top 4 placing as long as rider finishes within 2 laps of leader.
- In the event a rider wins all 4 sprints - they will be declared the winner and the race will be shortened by 2 laps.

Rules to understand:

- 2C4. Free laps up to a distance of 1300 meters (4 laps) may be taken in a case of a mishap. Upon returning to the track, the rider will assume the position (s)he occupied prior to the mishap. Riders taking free laps may not return to the track in the final kilometer. Riders who suffer a mishap and do not return to the track will not be placed.

What is a mishap?

- Mishap: A crash or a mechanical accident (tire puncture or other failure of an essential component). However, a puncture caused by the tire coming off due to inadequate gluing is not a mechanical accident, nor is a malfunction due to missassembly or insufficient tightening of any component. A recognized mishap is a stoppage that meets the above conditions. An unrecognized mishap is a stoppage where the above conditions are not met.
